## Re: Duquesne Light Company – Results for the March 17, 2025, Request for Proposals

Dear Mr. Peoples:

On March 18, 2025, CRA International, Inc. d/b/a Charles River Associates filed Duquesne Light Company's (DLC) results of its DSP X procurement process and rules for the March 2025 Solicitation for DLC's default service customers. The filing includes bid results for a Full Requirements RFP for the supply for residential, small commercial & industrial (C&I), and medium C&I customers who will receive default service from DLC within the period June 1, 2025, through May 31, 2027. The March 2025 Solicitation results also include one product in an Hourly Price Auction for DLC's large C&I customers for the 12-month period June 1, 2025, through May 31, 2026. All products were procured via declining clock auctions.

This filing was submitted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules that were approved as modified by the Commission's Order, entered January 14, 2025, at Docket No. P-2024-3048592. DLC requests that the Commission approve the bid results of the March 2025 Solicitation on or before March 19, 2025.

Further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, since the results of the March 2025 Solicitation appear to have been conducted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules as approved by the Commission.

Therefore, we direct DLC to disclose the results of this March 2025 Solicitation in accordance with the Commission's Secretarial Letter in <u>Re: Disclosure of Default Service Solicitation Results and</u> <u>Creation of a Default Service Rate Calculation Model</u>, issued October 12, 2010, at Docket No. M-2009-2082042.
